Responsible Artificial Intelligence

In this talk, after briefly introducing the History of AI, I'll concentrate on recent developments that aim at building responsible AI systems centred on human values and with explainable properties. Responsible AI is a wide-ranging field encompassing many open questions regarding the moral, legal and technical issues that arise with using and designing ethically-compliant autonomous agents. Under this umbrella, the computational ethics area is concerned with formulating and codifying ethical principles into software components. I will look at a particular problem in computational ethics: engineering moral values into autonomous agents.
